






Task Force Progress

- <u>November 2013:</u> (Washington, DC) BEG introduced concept to gage international interest in collaborative offshore projects.
- March, 2014: (Seoul, Korea) US DOE volunteers to lead CSLF Task Force, committee formed (7 countries).
 - USA, UK, Australia, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, China
- <u>September 2015</u>: (Regina, Canada) Findings and conclusions of the Task Force Report presented.
- <u>November 2015</u> (Riyadh, Saudi Arabia) Final report submitted (http://www.cslforum.org/publications/documents/OffshoreStorageTaskForce_FinalCombinedReport.pdf)
